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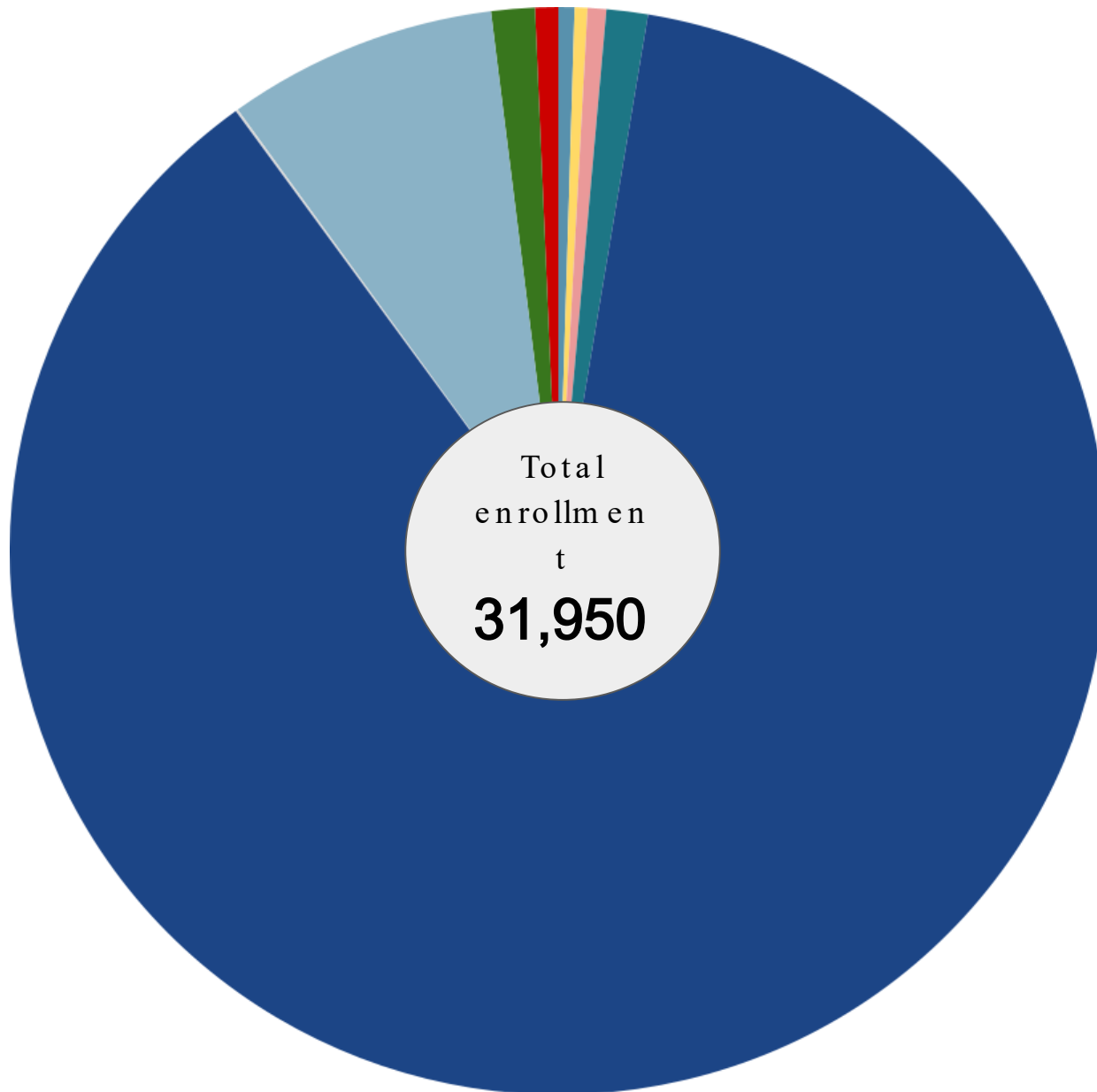

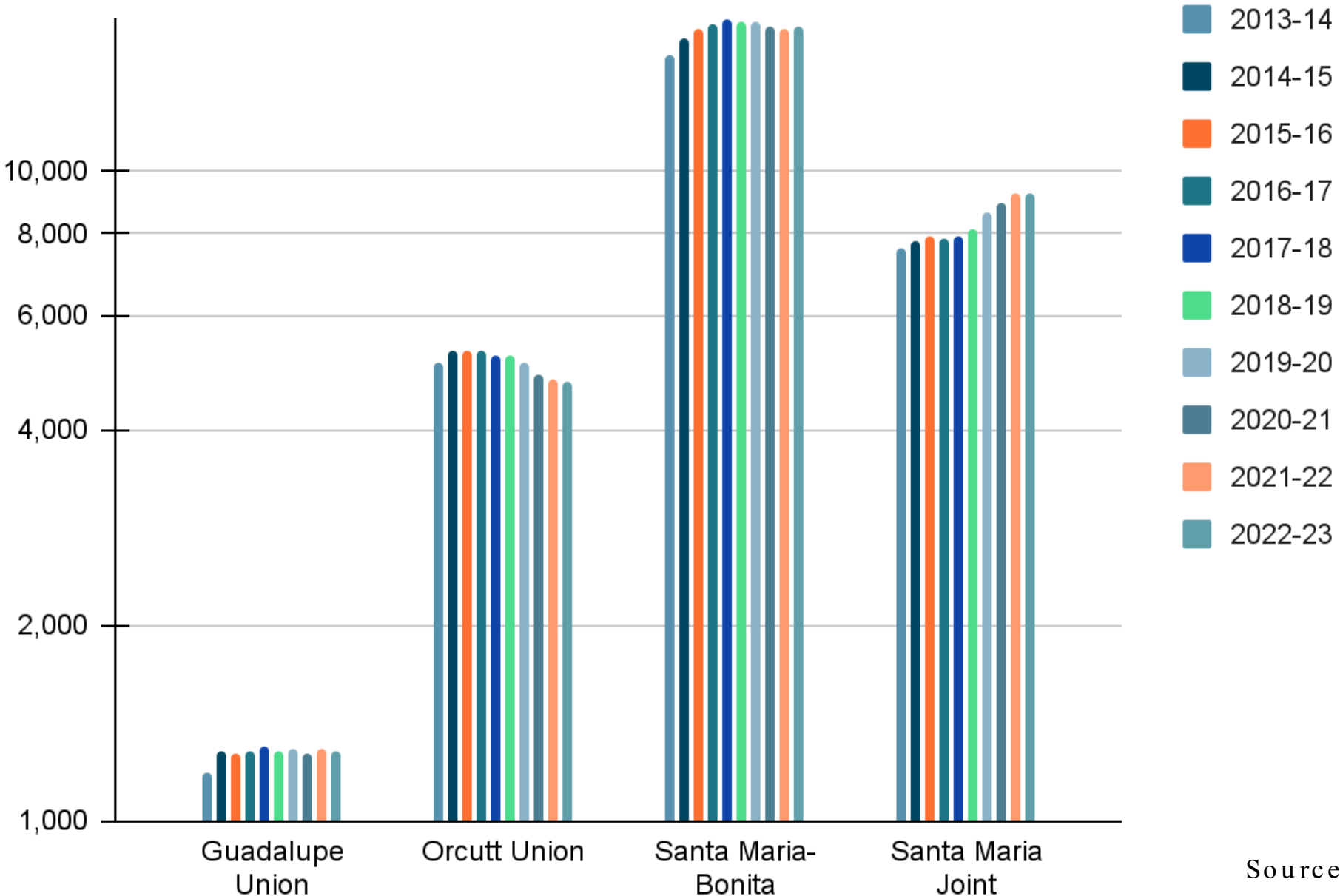

# -year enrollment trends

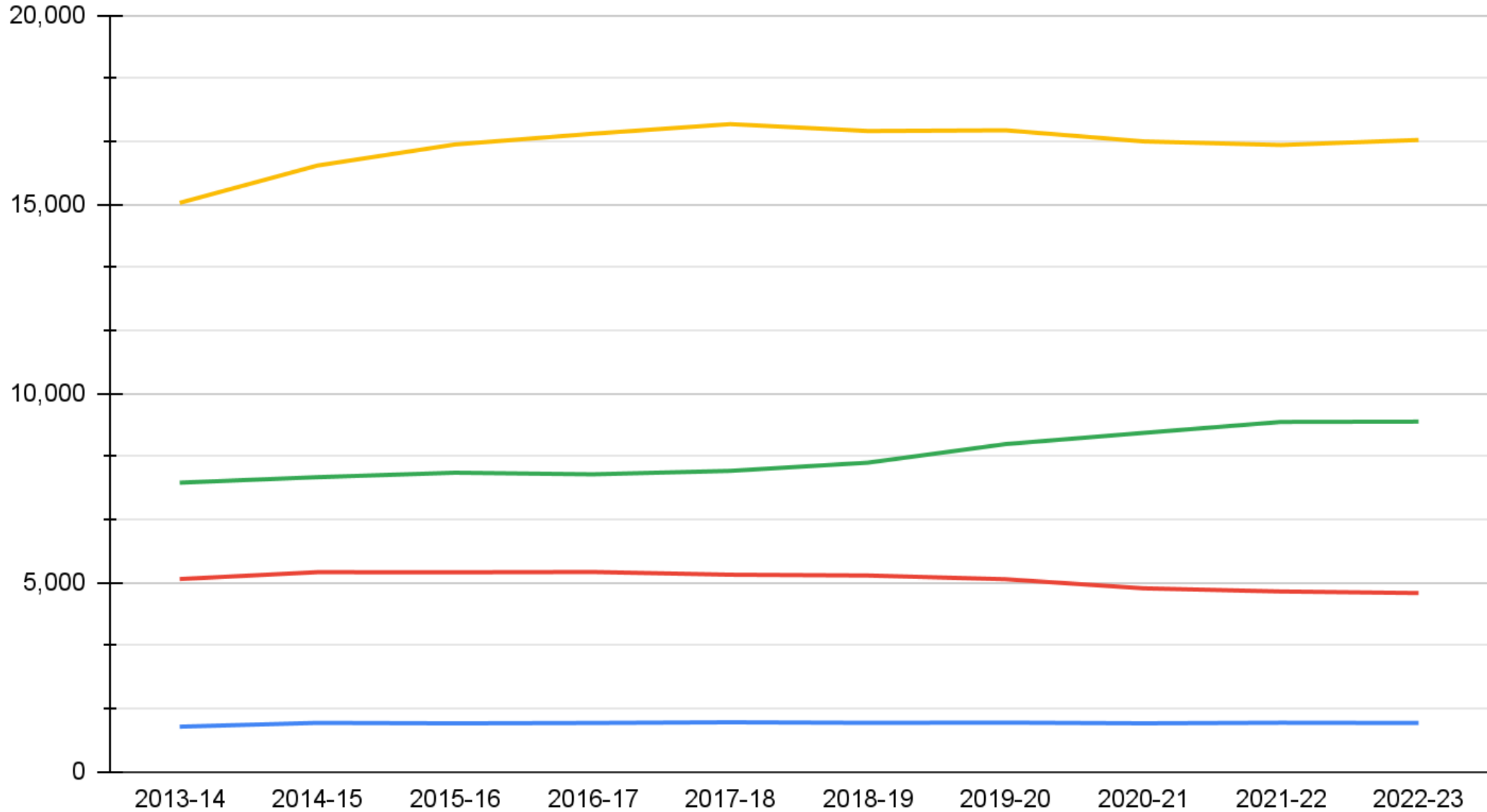

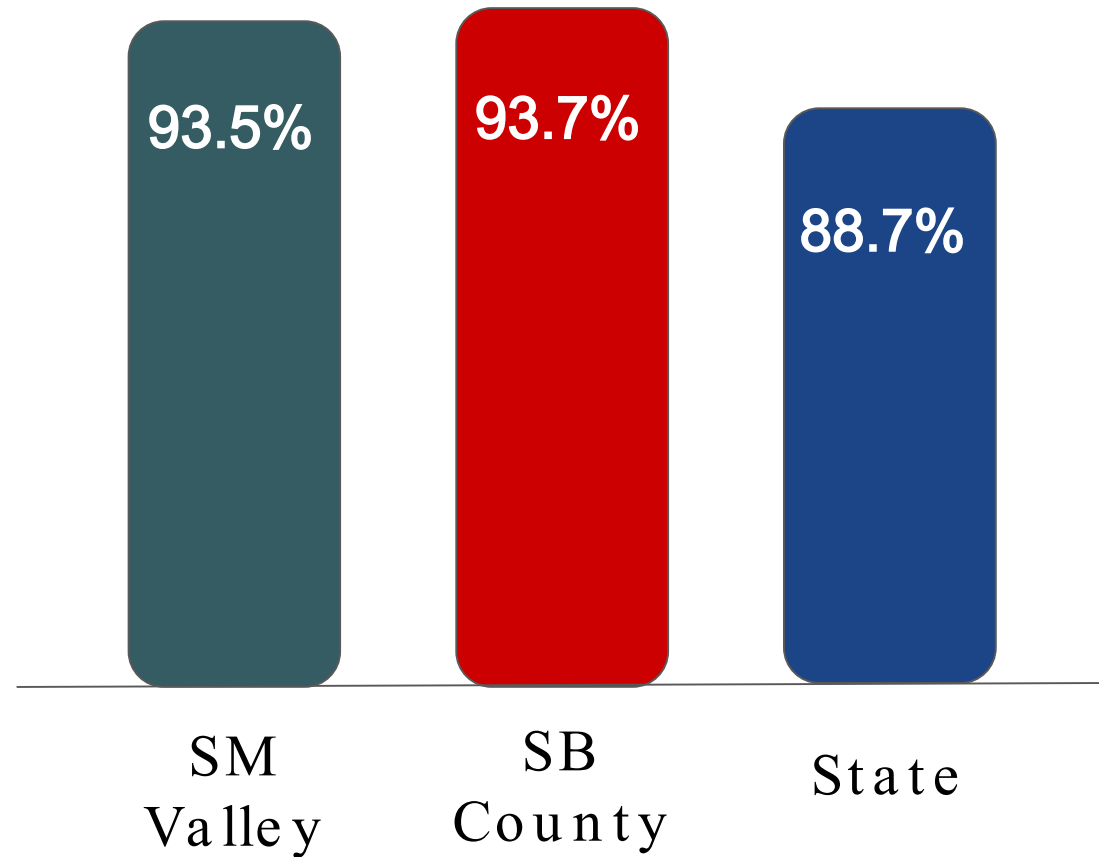

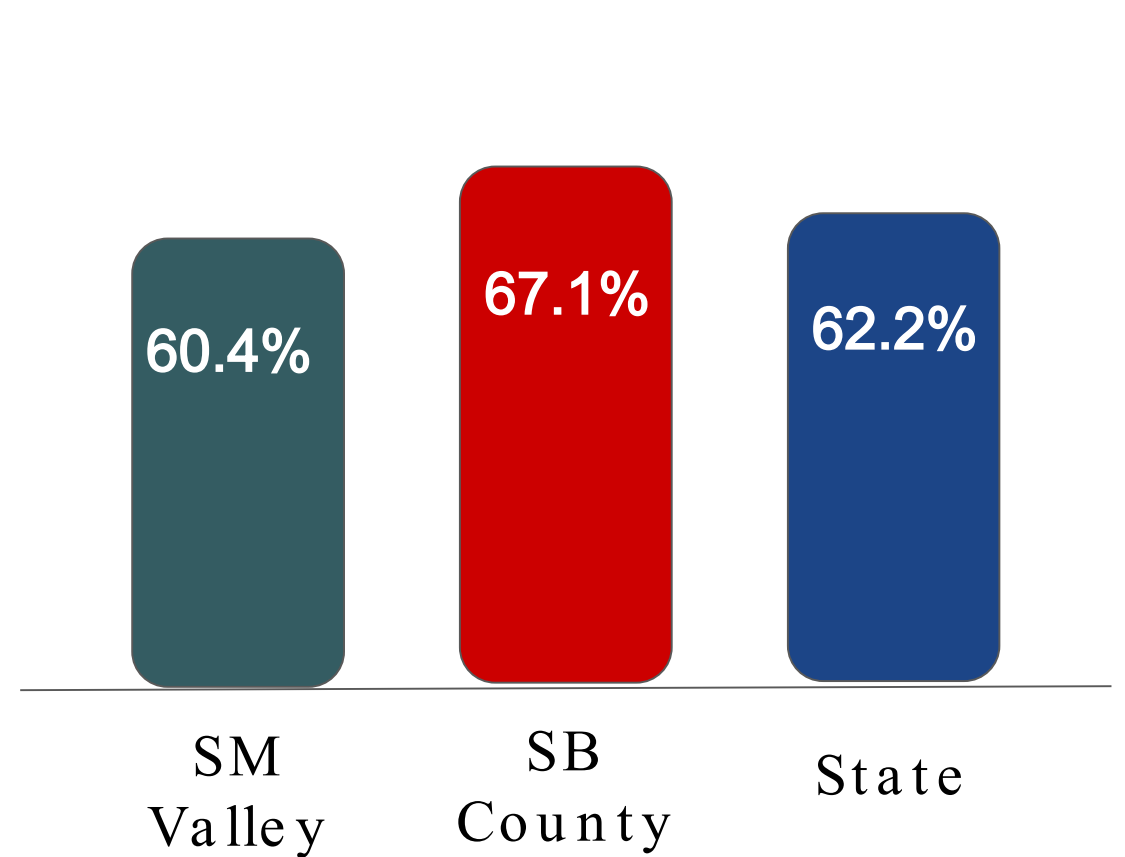
## High School Graduation Rate

Most recent data: 2022-23



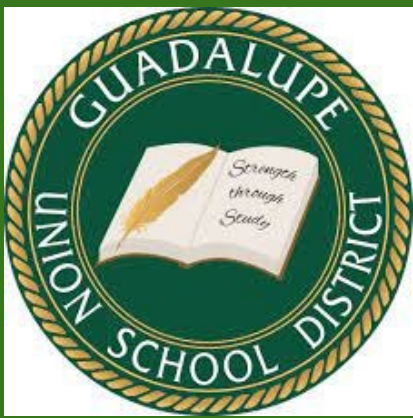
## College -Going Rate

### MENTAL HEALTH THERAPIST

Addresses emotional issues with their relationships while sessions are typical

### PSYCHOLOGIST

Can conduct structured sessions with and relationships typical

### PSYCHIATRIST

Diagnose and treat on physical impact. Can prescribe and a 1 hour assessment to assist in the diagnosis. Sessions are typical

### CONSENT & COMMON TYPES

- With your consent, the therapist can create a treatment plan because a therapist can show you new issues, a psychiatrist or pediatrician can inform you on health care, break confidentiality, others, or
- CBT/cognitive therapy that relationships

### PROFESIONALES DE LA SALUD

**TERAPEUTA** • LCSW • LMFT • LPCC  
Aborda los desafíos emocionales a través de una variedad de intervenciones terapéuticas. Puede ayudar a las personas a resolver problemas con sus pensamientos, emociones y relaciones mientras las habilidades de afrontamiento saludables. Las sesiones duran entre 45-60 minutos.

**PSICÓLOGO** • PhD • PsyD  
Puede realizar evaluaciones y pruebas estructuradas para abordar los desafíos emocionales a través de una variedad de intervenciones terapéuticas. Puede ayudar a las personas a resolver problemas con sus pensamientos, emociones y relaciones mientras las habilidades de afrontamiento saludables. Las sesiones duran entre 45-60 minutos.

**PSIQUIATRA** • MD • DO  
Diagnostica y trata enfermedades mentales con un enfoque en los impactos físicos y el manejo de medicamentos. Puede prescribir y administrar medicamentos. La primera visita es una evaluación de diagnóstico y una evaluación de sangre, etc. (informes escolares, análisis de sangre, etc.). Las sesiones duran entre 15 y 30 minutos, según sea necesario.

### CONSENTIMIENTO Y CONFIDENCIALIDAD

- Con su consentimiento, la información de su salud puede ser compartida con otros profesionales de la salud para ayudarlos a brindar el mejor cuidado posible.
- El terapeuta y el psiquiatra pueden colaborar y trabajar juntos para crear un plan de tratamiento que sea efectivo porque un terapeuta puede ser más efectivo que un psiquiatra por sí solo. El psiquiatra puede proporcionar una visión más amplia de su salud mental y puede ser útil para responder a nuevas preguntas. También puede ser útil mantener informados a los jóvenes, de 12 a 17 años, sobre su salud mental y ayudarlos a romper la barrera de la confidencialidad de los padres. El terapeuta debe romper la confidencialidad si sospecha que el joven está en peligro.

### TIPOS COMUNES DE TERAPIA

- La TCC/Terapia Conductual Cognitiva es una conversación estructurada que puede ayudar a las personas a manejar sus pensamientos, sentimientos y comportamientos.
- La terapia psicodinámica es una terapia que se centra en el arte de considerar las relaciones pasadas que afectan el comportamiento y las relaciones pasadas afectan el comportamiento.
- La terapia familiar reúne a los miembros de la familia para identificar problemas, resolver problemas y trabajar en habilidades para hacer frente y comunicación.
- Los grupos de apoyo ayudan a las personas a conectarse y a aprender de las experiencias de otros.

### COMMUNICATION & CONNECTION

Active listening shows respect and builds trust

- Be patient and don't interrupt.
- Remember, it's about the person, not you.
- Use "I" statements to convey what you observe.
- Be aware of your body language & your expression.
- Don't minimize or trivialize their experience or feelings.
- Notice body language and emotions behind their words.
- Sometimes listening is enough. It is not your job to fix them.

Our words matter...

I wanted to check in, I've noticed you don't seem like yourself lately. Are you ok?  
You are not alone. I am here for you.  
I may not understand exactly how you feel, but I care and I can listen.  
I can see you are feeling frustrated right now.  
I am not available right now but I want to support you. Can I check back with you later?

That sounds really difficult. I see why you feel this way.  
Do you want advice or would you rather I just listen?  
I'd like your input on how we can resolve this.  
If you want to sit with me, I understand what you said.  
I see it this way... How do you see it?  
It sounds like you're feeling... Are you feeling...?

### CHARACTERISTICS OF RELATIONS

I AM WORTHY. I AM ENOUGH. I MATTER.

- KINDNESS**  
I deserve a partner or friend who is able to compromise, and who respects my boundaries.
- COMMUNICATION**  
I deserve someone I can talk to who listens, makes me feel heard, and validates my feelings.
- LOYALTY & TRUST**  
I deserve someone who is honest, committed, and supports me.
- STRONG CHARACTER**  
I deserve someone who is confident and brings out the best in me.
- RESPECT**  
I deserve someone who treats me as an equal, respects my boundaries, thoughts, my opinions, and my body. I have the right to ask for space, and to set boundaries.

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### ABC'S OF SELF-CARE

Self-care is any activity you do to take care of your physical, emotional, and mental health...

- physical:** sleep, exercise, play, healthy eating, disconnect from screens
- emotional:** spend time with friends and family, set healthy boundaries, ask for what you need from others
- mental:** practice mindfulness and deep breathing, stay in the moment, develop healthy coping strategies, show compassion for yourself and others

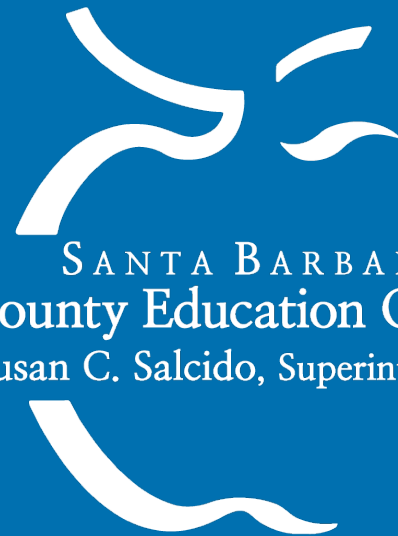
